#### The Tour at a Glance

Great Barrier Island (Aotea) is a wild little slice of paradise — remote, rugged, and full of that classic Kiwi charm. With only about 1,000 locals, it's one of the most peaceful and laid-back spots in the South Pacific.

Breathe in the salty ocean air mixed with the earthy scent of native bush. Every breath feels like a reset. Spend your days exploring winding trails through volcanic peaks, lush forests, golden beaches, and crystal clear waters. Adventure and relaxation go hand-in-hand here.

On Great Barrier Island, Nature runs the show and we wouldn't have it any other way.

Getting there is part of the fun too! It's just a 30 minute scenic flight from Auckland (note: flight not included in the tour price).

## **Trip Grading: Moderate**

Ideal for anyone comfortable walking up to 20km on formed tracks and trails with some average to steep inclines at times.

#### Pre-tour

Please come dressed ready to walk and make sure you've got a full drink bottle, as we head straight into our first walk as soon as you land.

The breath-taking flight from Auckland and the sparkling, island-dotted waters of the Hauraki Gulf sets the perfect scene for what's to come. As you step off the plane, your friendly guide will be there to welcome you. You've officially arrived in paradise!

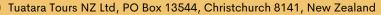

They all hold current first aid certificates, passenger driving licences and are the very best people to ensure your experience will be one to remember.



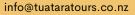
















# Day 1 Southern Shores (8-10kms, 3-4hrs)

Come ready to walk, bring a full drink bottle and let the adventure begin!

A stunning flight over Auckland and the turquoise waters of the Hauraki Gulf sets the scene. Your friendly guide welcomes you to paradise!

We head to Whangaparapara for a warm-up walk on the Te Ahumata / White Cliffs Track, following an old mining road to a summit with rare orchids and panoramic views. If you're up for more, stroll the golden sands of Blind Bay or visit Kauri Falls for a refreshing dip in a natural swimming hole.

Then it's time to unwind at the lodge with a drink and a grazing platter on the deck, followed by a delicious two-course Kiwi-style dinner.

# Day 2 Heart & Soul - Mt Hobson (16kms, 6-7hrs)

Today we take on the island's most spectacular hike—The Aotea Track. We'll start with a magical walk through mossy Windy Canyon, then climb through lush native forest, across bridges and stairways, all the way to the summit of Mt Hobson/Hirakimata. Along the way, wander through wetlands home to rare birds and towering podocarps, and explore relics from the island's logging past.

At 621 metres, Mt Hobson is the island's highest point—and the 360° views are incredible. On the way down, we pass through the delicate Kaitoke Wetlands, alive with orchids and birdlife, before unwinding in natural hot pools nestled in the bush.

Back at the lodge, we'll enjoy a hearty home-cooked dinner on the deck, overlooking the calm waters of Whangaparapara Harbour.

# Day 3 Northern Shores (8-10kms, 5hrs)

Today we head north to Port Fitzroy, where lush hills meet crystal-clear water. We hike through nīkau forests and across swing bridges to the secluded Bush's Beach.

Next, a short climb up Warren's Creek Track leads to a waterfall and deep forest pools — perfect for a refreshing swim. After lunch, we explore the island's largest white sand beach, with a scenic coastal walk past bird colonies and a historic shipwreck. Swim, stretch out, and soak up the beauty.

We end the day back at the lodge with a homemade meal and a cold drink — well-earned after an epic day out. MEALS INCLUDED: B L D

# Day 4 Left of Centre (8-10kms, 3-4hrs)

We finish our Aotea adventure with a stunning walk down to the island's southern coast. From the Whalers Lookout track, we'll enjoy sweeping views and may even spot Bryde's whales cruising the calm waters of the Hauraki Gulf. After a relaxed picnic, we follow a scenic ridgeline trail through puriri trees and nikau palms, with views stretching to both coasts.

Our final stop is the gorgeous Medlands Beach—pure white sand, tidal rock pools, and the iconic Memory Rock. Take time to explore, reflect, or simply soak it all in.

Before heading to the airport, there's time for a quick visit to the island museum or a coffee at the local gallery. Then it's off to Claris Airport for your 5pm flight, full of memories from an unforgettable trip.

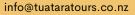

Alcohol - Two complimentary glasses of New Zealand wine or craft beer per person are included each evening, you are most welcome to bring your own beverages if you wish.

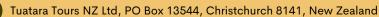
Pre- and post-tour accommodation

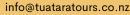












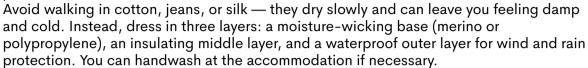






#### Your travel check list:

The following is a list of recommended items. Please also use your own experience to supplement this list. If you're unsure about anything, feel free to contact us. Raincoats, back packs, and hiking poles can be organised for you at no cost but these need to be pre booked.

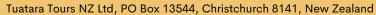




Waterproof rain jacket with hood (a must) and waterproof over trousers (if you have them)
Boots or sturdy walking shoes with ankle support, spare laces
Thermals (top and bottom) merino or polypropylene are recommended
Polar fleece jacket or top (mid layer)
Gloves, warm hat
Woolen or thermal hikers socks 3-4 pair
Hiking shorts or zip off long trousers (quick-dry fabric-no jeans). Gaiters, if you have them.
Drink Bottle
Medium size (35-40I) day pack with waterproof liner
Camera/ phone and charger/ torch
Sun hat , sun glasses sun block,
Swimsuit and small towel
One set of casual wear for the evening, including casual shoes or sandals
Personal toiletries and essential medications, a small personal first aid kit, insect repellant
Hiking Poles (if you normally use them)

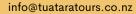






















## Frequently asked questions:

#### How do I book a tour?

A deposit of \$300 per person confirms your place and can be paid via credit card (Visa or Mastercard, no surcharge) through our website: <a href="https://www.tuataratours.co.nz/make-a-payment/">https://www.tuataratours.co.nz/make-a-payment/</a>, or by bank transfer to Tuatara Tours NZ Ltd: 01 0797 0308837 00.

#### When is the balance due?

The final balance is due 90 days prior to departure. A reminder will be sent via email. You're welcome to pay in instalments, as long as the full amount is received by the due date.

#### What if I need to cancel?

Our cancellation policy for the Great Barrier Island Escape is:

- Outside 60 days, Non refundable deposit, date changes are possible but deposits are non-refundable
- 60-31 days, 30% cancellation fee
- Within 30 days 100% cancellation fee

These terms are non negotiable so we strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance in case of unforeseen events. This tour is operated in conjunction with a local tour operator, Walking Legends.

#### How big are the groups?

Our tours typically accommodate up to 12 people, though we can cater to larger groups on request.

#### Do I have to share a room?

Tours are priced on a twin-share basis (two people per room). Let us know if you prefer a queen bed or two singles. Solo travellers will be paired with another solo of the same gender, or you can opt to pay a single supplement for your own room.

#### Am I fit enough?

The Great Barrier Island Escape is graded Moderate, suited to walkers with an above average fitness level. You should feel confident walking 20km on formed tracks and roads with average to steep inclines at times. Not sure if it's right for you? Just give our team a call, we're happy to chat.

#### How much luggage can I bring?

For the flight from Auckland Airport to Claris Airport with <u>Barrier Air</u>, you'll have a carry-on luggage limit of 7kg per person. If you have booked a Premium ticket for your flight this comes with a 20kg luggage limit for checked-in bags (excess baggage fees will apply if you exceed this). Once you land at Claris Airport, we'll stow your gear in our vehicles and it'll be waiting for you at the end of the day when we get back to the lodge. Complimentary hire of raincoats, backpacks, and hiking poles is available by prior arrangement.

#### When is the best time to do the tour?

Our season runs from October to January and we can also offer tours in April. We cannot offer tours in February and March due to peak demand. Tours run in all weather, so come prepared. Please refer to our gear list for what to bring.

#### Can you pick me up for the tour?

Most walkers fly from Auckland airport on the morning of the tour. Your guide will meet you at 10:30am at Claris Airport, Great Barrier Island for an 11am start.

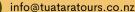

# Frequently asked questions:

#### What time do we return to Claris Airport for the flight back to Auckland?

On the final day you are dropped back to Claris Airport in time for a 5pm flight back to Auckland.

Can you help with air ticket bookings? If you need assistance with booking airfares to the Island, just let us know. If you are happy to book your own airfares, we recommend a 10.30am arrival (or earlier) and a 5pm departure on the last day (or later). These times work best for the start and finish of the walk.

#### Is breakfast included on the first day?

Please have breakfast before your pick-up on the first day, as the tour begins immediately afterward. From then on, all meals are included as per your itinerary.

#### What kind of meals are provided?

Enjoy fresh continental breakfasts with tea and good plunger coffee (barista coffee available for purchase). Packed lunches are made daily with a variety of nutritious options, and dinners are two-course, Kiwi-style meals featuring seasonal produce, veggies, and salads. Two complimentary drinks are included with dinner each night, and you're welcome to bring your own beverages.

#### What facilities are available at the lodge?

All three nights are spent at the same comfortable lodge, so you can really settle in. The lodge runs on a solar power system with a backup generator, making it an ideal choice for sustainability and low-impact travellers. Each room includes a small refrigerator, tea and coffee making facilities, and a well-equipped kitchenette. We recommend leaving hair dryers and straighteners at home, as they can overload the power system.

**Is WiFi available?** Wi-Fi is available throughout the lodge and in your room, though speeds may vary during peak times. The service is turned off overnight to conserve lodge battery capacity. There is intermittent service while we are out on the trails.

Are there drying facilities at the Lodge? There are no laundry facilities available for guests at Great Barrier Lodge. There are plenty of wide, covered verandas for drying wet gear.

**Is alcohol included?** Two complimentary glasses of wine or craft beer per person are offered each evening and you are most welcome to bring your own beverages if you wish.

**Do I need hiking boots?** We strongly recommend well-fitting walking boots with good tread and ankle support. After periods of rain certain sections of trail can be muddy, so hiking boots will be best to tackle this. On the day where we do the Hirakimata/Mt. Hobson track hiking boots are a must-have as the terrain can be challenging.

**Do I carry a full pack?** No! You'll only need to carry a day pack with the essentials, wet weather gear, lunch, a drink bottle, sunhat, and anything else you'd like for the day. Since you return to the same lodge each night, there's no need to bring your full luggage on the trail. We have raincoats, day packs and pairs of hiking poles that you are welcome to borrow for the trip, just let us know in advance.

**Are the tours guided?** Yes, the Great Barrier Island Escape is a fully guided experience. Your guide will bring local knowledge to enhance your journey and ensure your safety and comfort along the way.

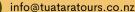

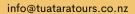

#### **Cancellation Policy Due to Travel Restrictions**

If your trip is impacted by travel restrictions imposed by the New Zealand government or any other government, Tuatara Tours will either work with you to transfer your trip to a future date at no additional cost, or provide a full refund.

#### **Price**

All prices are quoted in New Zealand dollars and include 15% GST. Prices are based on rates current at the time of publishing. Tuatara Tours reserves the right to modify prices without notice if deemed necessary or appropriate.

**Accommodation** on organised tours is based on twin or double share. Solo travellers will be paired with another traveller of the same sex. A single supplement is available upon request.

#### **Confirmation of Booking**

#### **Changes to Tours**

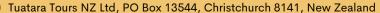

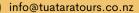
















#### **TERMS & CONDITIONS**

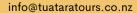

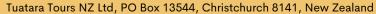

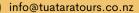
